BREED NOTES:

Young horses (thru 3 yrs) shall be shown in-hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. Bridles are mandatory on 2 yr. olds and older. Young horses judged 60% movement, 30% conf., 10% gen. impressions. Mature horses (4 years and older) judged 50% movement, 40% conf., 10% gen. impressions. Class 20 must be pre-entered; horses and owners must be members of AHS. Class 21 entered under dam, one entry fee per group. Class 22 entered under sire, one entry fee per group. Please note new rule for 2007: (DR 205.3) "Each horse entered in a group class must have an individual entry form completed and on file with the competition secretary, even if the horse is not competing in other classes. USEF fees and at least at USEF HID must be submitted for each horse in a group entry." No fees for championships. Under saddle classes to be shown at w-t-c both ways.

MCDEVITT SOTHEY'S GRAND SLAM:

\$1,000 - winner take all - to the Grand Champion of the Sotheby's Stakes 2012 series. Must ride a Sotheby's Stakes Musical Freestyle (any level) and a Sotheby Stakes class (equivalent level) in three of the four shows (March Magic, Dressage at Lexington, Pinehurst Fall, Harvest Moon). All scores combined and averaged; if participating in all four shows, best three count. Prize money awarded at Harvest Moon.

PERFORMANCE DIVISION NOTES

The Sporting Horse Amateur Challenge – Training and First Level – Open to amateur riders that have never competed above Intermediate I. Horse and rider combination to enter two tests on Saturday and one test on Sunday (either Training or First Level). The lowest score will be dropped and the remaining scores averaged to determine a winner at Training and a winner at First Level.

Second-Third-Fourth & PSG/I-1 Level – Open to amateur riders that have never competed above I-1. Second Level Riders must enter two second level classes, one on Friday and one on Saturday, Third Level Riders must enter two third level classes, one on Friday and one on Saturday, Fourth Level Riders must enter two fourth level classes, one on Friday and one on Saturday, PSG/I-1 Riders must enter two PSG/I-1 classes, one on Friday and one on Saturday (may select PSG or I-1). The two scores will be averaged to determine the winner at Second, Third, Fourth & PSG/I-1 levels.

SHAC AMATEURS:

USEF AA status not required, but by entering the SHAC, competitors declare themselves as Amateurs according to USEF GR 808; Juniors/Young Riders may also compete in the SHAC.

All SHAC winners will receive a prize and participate in an awards ceremony. 3 or 4 riders of any level may join up for a team competition with the three best averages used to determine the winning teams. There is no extra fee for the team competition.

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES: Horses and riders participating only in Opportunity classes are exempt from Federation and affiliate organization membership and Horse Identification (HID) requirements, non-member fees and \$15 USEF fee.

Please indicate on the entry form whether you are entering SHAC or BLM-Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Qualifier 2012 or USDF/GAIG-Q Greater American Insurance Group Qualifier 2012 classes; for USDF/GAIG-Q qualifiers ONLY add \$10 to class fee as indicated on entry form. For Test of Choice (TOC) please indicate which test you are riding. There will be \$500 prize money awarded to the winners of classes 251 - The Prix St. George Challenge, class 371 - Grand Prix TOC and 361 - Intermediate I.

\$300 McDevitt Sotheby's Freestyle Challenge: (Classes 2812, 2834, 285 and 286: Sponsored by McDevitt Sotheby's International Realty. Each class ranked and pinned separately, but combined for prize money. Highest Percentage: \$150; Second: \$100; Third: \$50.

\$250 Sotheby's Stakes (Classes 111, 121, 131, 141, 150 and 160): sponsored by McDevitt Sotheby's International Realty. Winner receives \$150 and trophy, second: \$100 and third \$50.

TIMES/ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS: Confirmation sent via e-mail. Be sure to include a legible e-mail address. Times also available on the website 5 days prior to the show. www.dressageatlexington.com

STABLING: Large permanent box stalls (10x10) with doors available: initial bedding provided. Riders must provide an emergency contact and phone number on the stabling portion of the entry.

\$110 per stall/per weekend (Thursday 7/12 through Sunday, 7/15 7 p.m.). \$60 per stall per day. Early arrivals need prior approval.

Pursuant to USEF rule GR1210.4 each barn has one sharps container per 50 horses. Competition management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

ARENAS: Competition: 2 indoor coliseums, 6 outdoor rings with all weather footing. All are 20 x 60 m. Warm-up: 1 large covered, 4 outdoor and one small indoor all with all weather footing. Lunging allowed in posted areas.

DIRECTIONS: FROM I-81 ONTO I-64: at Lexington, VA exit I-64 at first exit (Lexington) and follow signs to the Virginia Horse Center.

OTHER: Food available on grounds. Exhibitors Barn Party Friday night after the Breed Division.
